“I like to carry American-made items and support the local artist, because the American artist is getting more scarce,” Migray says. “Many artists have great stories to go with their products. We pass this along to our customers, and it makes what they buy all that more special.”

**Mona Lisa necklace, \$47.95.** Inspire your philanthropic side with this item by Praols, a company that employs only women with disabled children.
