Bev Keller, the mother, dressed the other women in colored eyelet, although she hadn't planned to in the beginning.

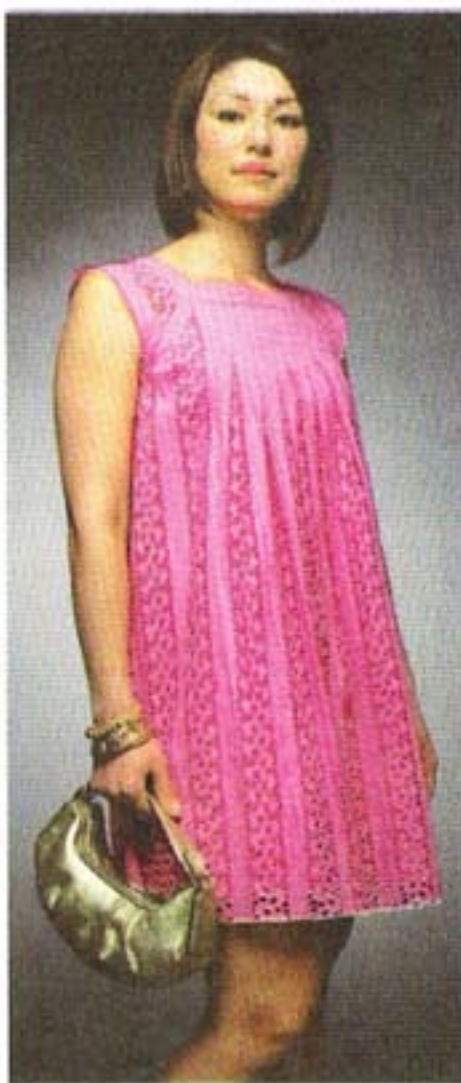
